



Dan was born January 20, 1954, in Port Chester New York. In June 1972, he enlisted in the USAF. He completed Administrative Specialist School at Keesler AFB, Mississippi in October the same year. He also completed the Postal Operations Course at Keesler during March 1974 and the Postal Supervisor Course at Ft Benjamin Harris, Indiana, in March 1990. He earned an Associate Degree in Administrative Management through the Community College of the Air Force and a Associate Degree in Business Management through Central Texas College. He also earned a Bachelor Degree in Sociology through the University of Columbia in 1998. Dan is currently the Facility Coordinator for the Dept of Human Resources, Organization and Training Development, State of Georgia. His office is in Macon Georgia at the Middle Georgia Training Center.

He completed NCO Leadership School (PACAF) and the NCO Academy (PACAF) winning the Speech Award and graduating as Distinguished Graduate and Commandant Award winner in both courses. Dan was also a Distinguished Graduate from the Senior NCO Academy.
